A. German Police and SS.

Traffic has increased somewhat with a rise in Nap and Rummy. New frequencies have been observed. New call signs have appeared in Italy. A new No. 7 traffic in Yugoslavia has been broken. 10 reincodings have been detected and four dealt with including one Pontoon squared.

Intelligence. The present distribution of the Police in Italy comprises a H.Q. for the B&O at GARDONE on Lake Garda, SS. Pol. Regt. 15 at BOLZANO, three further Bns. of which one is to be sent to VERONA and one to MADDALONI near Naples, and a new Tirolese regiment which is to be formed with cadres of NCO's drawn from the Galician SS. Volunteer Regts. A police training Bn. has been moved from Czechoslovakia to LAON. The new Yugoslav key gives details of the pacification of SYMBIA by HSSuff. Kroatien with the help of LIX Res. Korps. The police from TSCHERNIGOW have been used for trench digging West of the DWJEF; GOMEL is being evacuated. Bomb damage has been reported from BERLIN, MANNHEIM, LUDWIGSHAFEN, DUISBURG, MUNICH.

2. SS. Keys. 5 Quince days have been received and 120 messages issued. SS. Kav. Div. in the CHARKOW area had 1500 casualties in 15 days and reports its fighting strength as 600 men. There are some indications that SS. Div. das Reich and Totenkopf are moving. SS. Div. Prinz Eugen is still operating in the Dalmatian coastal area. Himmler has forbidden the further recruiting of Albanians.

B. Non-Indicator.

Two groups of M 70 and one group of M 90 were broken.
